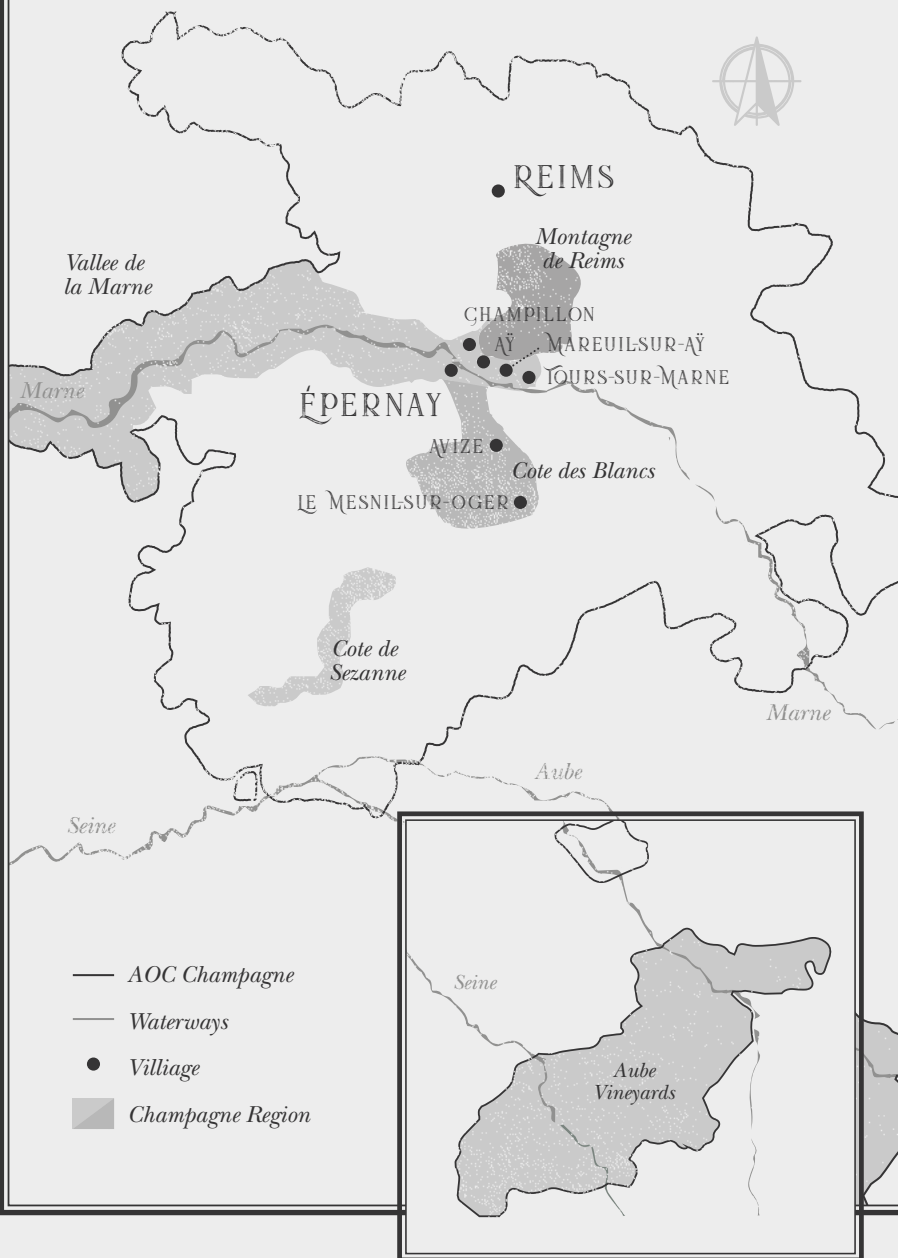

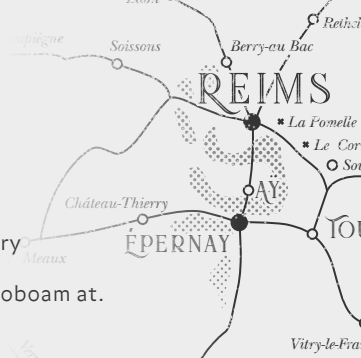

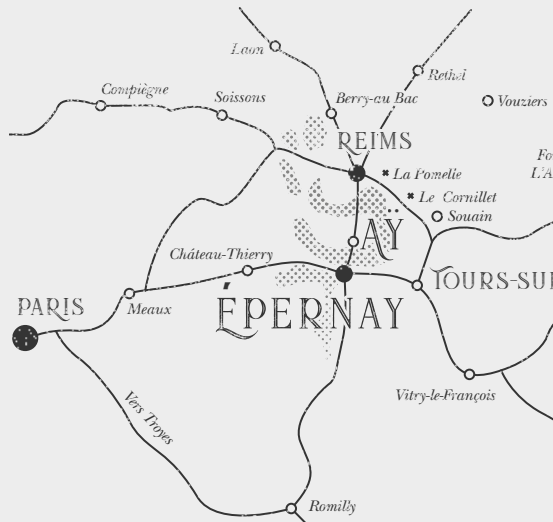

TOURS-SUR-MARNE

Another Grand Cru Village. Technically the village is in the Vallée de la Marne but the vineyards are very much a part of the terroir of the Montagne de Reims: all about that Pinot Noir.

LAURENT-PERRIER

Bernard de Nonancourt brought the house back from the brink after fighting in the French Resistance during WWII. His legacy lives on through his daughters who manage the house today. Vive la France!
